

# It's A Celebration Birthday Card



## Supplies:

**Stamps:** Birthday Bash Sentiments

**Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black (Tsukineko)

**Paper:** Pumpkin Pie CS, Basic Black CS, Whisper White CS, Sweet and Sour Specialty DP (Stampin' Up!)

**Accessories:** Perfect Polka Dots embossing folder, Big Shot, Stampin' Dimensionals (Stampin' Up!); double-sided adhesive (Thermo web); Corner Chomper (We Are Memory Keepers)

## Dimensions:

- Pumpkin Pie CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece scored at 5 ½" and folded in half to create a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card
- Whisper White CS: a 3 ½" x 4 ¼" piece
- Basic Black CS: a 3 11/16" x 4 ¼" piece
- Patterned Paper: four 1 ½" x 1 ½" pieces

## Directions:

1. Emboss the front of the Pumpkin Pie card with the Perfect Polka Dots embossing folder and your Big Shot.
2. Round the top and bottom opposing corners of the four pieces of patterned paper with the ½" side of the Corner Chomper.
3. Stamp the greeting in the center bottom of the Whisper White CS piece in black ink. Center and stick this piece onto the Basic Black CS piece.
4. Arrange the patterned paper squares onto the Whisper White CS piece. Stick the two opposing squares on with Stampin' Dimensionals, and the remaining two squares with double-sided adhesive.
5. Stick the matted Whisper White CS piece to the card front, about ¼" in from the right edge of the card. You're done!
