

# Birthday Pennant Card



## **Supplies:**

**Stamps:** Curly Cute (Stampin' Up!)

**Greeting Download:** provided by Sunny Stampin' Inc. & Paper Crafter's Library

**Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black ink (Tsukineko; BG07 Copic Sketch marker (Copic)

**Paper:** Basic Black CS, Daffodil Delight CS, Pacific Point CS, Real Red CS, Tempting Turquoise CS, Whisper White CS, Brights DP Stack - Daffodil Delight, Pacific Point, Real Red, Tempting Turquoise (Stampin' Up!)

**Accessories:** Petite Pennants Builder punch, 1/2" circle punch, 3/4" circle punch, 1/16" handheld circle punch, Stamp-a-ma-jig, Stampin' Dimensionals, Tombow Multi-Liquid Adhesive (Stampin' Up!); rhinestones (retired Stampin' Up!); black embroidery thread (craft store)

## **Dimensions:**

- Daffodil Delight CS: an 8" x 8" piece folded in half to create a 4" x 8" card, and scraps
- Basic Black CS: a 3 11/16" x 7 11/16"
- Daffodil Delight DP: a 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece and scraps
- Whisper White CS: an 8 1/2" x 11" piece to print Pennant Greetings onto
- Pacific Point, Real Red & Tempting Turquoise CS: scraps
- Pacific Point, Real Red, Tempting Turquoise DP: scraps

## **Directions:**

1. Print the Pennant Greetings onto the sheet of Whisper White CS. Punch out the desired greeting or letters with a 1/2" circle punch. Ink any rough edges of the punched letters with black ink.
2. Use the Petite Pennants Builder punch to punch out a set of pennants in Pacific Point DP, Real Red DP, Daffodil Delight DP and Tempting Turquoise DP. The scalloped pennant and the straight edge pennants should be punched out of different colors.
3. Punch a 3/4" circle from the following CS colors: Pacific Point, Real Red, Daffodil Delight and Tempting Turquoise.
4. Center and stick the straight edged pennant to the scalloped pennant with a double-sided adhesive. Stick the coordinating 3/4" CS circle to each pennant with a Stampin' Dimensional. Stick each punched letter from the greeting to the center of each CS circle with Tombow Multi-Liquid adhesive. Your pennants are now assembled.
5. Stamp the greeting in the bottom right of the Daffodil Delight DP in black ink. Center and stick this to the Basic Black CS piece.
6. Thread the pennants onto the floss and then stick them to the Daffodil Delight DP with Stampin' Dimensionals. Bring the ends of the floss around to the back of the CS and then stick them down. Center and stick this piece to the Daffodil Delight card front.
7. Color the rhinestone border with a Copic or Sharpie marker so that it coordinates with one of the colors of your pennants. Stick the border on either side of the greeting. You are finished.
