

Blossom Bouquet Birthday Card



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Sincere Salutations, Bold Blossoms (Stampin' Up!)
- **Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black Ink (Tsukineko); VersaMark, Melon Mambo Classic ink, Stampin' Pastels, Melon Mambo DP from Brights Patterns Stack (Stampin' Up!); black multi-liner (Copic)
- **Paper:** Crumb Cake CS, Very Vanilla CS, Sweet & Sour Specialty DP (Stampin' Up!)
- **Accessories:** embossing buddy, Wild Wasabi, Stampin' Dimensionals, mini glue dots, Blossom Bouquet Triple Layer punch, precision file (Stampin' Up!); buttons (to coordinate with flowers); coffee filter (other); heat tool (Ranger)

Dimensions:

- Daffodil Delight CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece folded in half to create a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card
- Whisper White CS: 3 ¾" x 5"
- Melon Mambo CS: a 4" x 5 ¼" piece
- Melon Mambo DP: a 3 ½" x 4 ¾" piece

Directions:

1. With the triple layer punch set to the solid flower, punch two flowers out of the Whisper White CS as directed by the video. Use a precision file to smooth out any rough edges.
2. Stamp the greeting in the bottom right of the Whisper White CS piece with black ink. Stamp the stems in VersaMark and emboss with Wild Wasabi embossing powder.
3. Center and stick the Melon Mambo DP to the Melon Mambo CS, and then center and stick this piece to the Daffodil Delight card front.
4. Center and stick the Whisper White CS onto the Melon Mambo CS piece using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Punch two flowers out of Daffodil Delight CS using the Blossom Bouquet Triple Layer punch. Stick the flowers to the center of the flower "windows" in the Whisper White CS using Stampin' Dimensionals. Stick a button to the center of each using mini glue dots.
6. Draw a dotted line to represent the flight path of the butterfly using a fine tip black pen.
7. Stamp the butterfly onto a scrap of Whisper White CS in Melon Mambo Classic ink. Cut out the butterfly. Color the center of the butterfly's wings with yellow Stampin' Pastel.
8. Stick the butterfly to the card with a Stampin' Dimensionals. You're finished.
