

# Chocolate Truffle Punch Project



## **Supplies:**

*All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.*

*\* denotes products from the Occasions Mini Catalogue*

- **Ink:** Sahara Sand Classic ink (105208), Rose Red Classic ink(101788), Chocolate Chip Classic ink (100908)
- **Stamps:** Itty Bitty Backgrounds (114996)
- **Paper:** Sahara Sand CS(105208), Close to Cocoa CS (101341), Very Vanilla CS(101650), Rose Red CS (102544), Rose Red DP (112162), Pixie Pink CS (105121)
- **Accessories:** Stamping Sponges (101610), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Big Shot (113439), Lots of Tags Sizzlit dies 114508), Gold Brads (104337), Naturally Serif (113453), Scallop Square punch (112081), 1" Circle punch (109046), Paper Snips (103579), Tombow Multi Purpose Adhesive (110755), Sticky Strip (104294)

## **Dimensions:**

- **Rose Red CS:** scraps
- **Rose Red DP:** scraps
- **Close to Cocoa:** scraps
- **Very Vanilla CS:** scraps
- **Pixie Pink CS:** scraps
- **Sahara Sand:** ½ sheet and scraps

## **Directions:**

1. Create your chocolate truffle using your Scallop Square Punch and your 1" circle punch. You will need a Scallop Square from Sahara Sand and two 1" circles. One from Close to Cocoa and one from Pixie Pink. Set aside.
2. Now follow your box template listed below and cut out. Sponge the outside with Sahara Sand and then take one of your stamps from the Itty bitty stamp set, and stamp randomly around using your Sahara Sand Classic ink.
3. Place your Strips of Sticky Strip along the edges indicated by the red lines in your template. Sharpen your creases and then set aside.
4. With your Big Shot, cut out the tag from your Rose Red DP scrap. Now cut out a second one from your Very Vanilla CS. Cut the trim from around the Very Vanilla CS and then mat the remaining oval on to the Rose Red DP tag. Place a Stampin' Dimensional on to the back of a truffle and then stick on in the center of the tag.
5. Stick the tag on to the lid portion of the box.
6. With your Big Shot, cut out the necessary letters from your Naturally Serif Alphabet, out of your Very Vanilla CS. Now sponge the edges of your letters heavily with Rose Red Classic ink. Stick each letter on to a scrap of Rose Red CS with Tombow Multi Purpose Adhesive. When the glue is dry, cut around leaving a small border. Set Aside.
7. Now you may assemble your box after removing the Sticky Strip backings. Once it is together you can close the lid and then stick on the letters used to express the sentiment. You are done.

## **Box Template:**

- the box template is 4" x 7" long.
- The red lines indicate Sticky Strip placement
- The arrows indicate the direction in which to cut your flaps
- The greyed out areas indicate the flaps for folding
- Score the box along its longest length at 1" and 3", score the CS along the shorter side at 1", 3", 4", 6", and 6"
