

Easter Card



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

Catalogue

- **Stamps:** Teeny Tiny Wishes, Picnic Parade*
- **Ink:** Jet Black Staz On; Creamy Caramel, Close to Cocoa, So Saffron, Almost Amethyst, Lovely Lilac, Pretty in Pink Classic inks
- **12" x 12" Paper:** Whisper White CS, So Saffron CS, Kraft CS, Shades of Spring DP, Tea Party DP
- **Accessories:** Bigz XL Matchbox die, Big Shot, Pretty in Pink Satin ribbon, Bone Folder, Stamp-a-ma-jig, Snail adhesive, Stampin' Dimensionals, mini glue dots, Stamping Sponge, button from stash (non-Stampin' Up!), 2-way glue pen

Directions:

1. Take a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of Kraft CS and fold it in half with your bone folder to create a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card.
2. Center and stick four 2" x 2" squares of DP (each in a different pattern) onto a 4 ½" x 4 ½" piece of Whisper White CS.
3. Lay a 5 ½" piece of Pretty in Pink Satin ribbon across the center of the Whisper White CS square. Bring the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the CS and stick them down with Snail adhesive.
4. Center and stick the Whisper White CS square onto a 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of So Saffron CS.
5. Center and stick the So Saffron CS onto the Kraft card front.
6. Stamp the bunny image from the Picnic Parade stamp set onto a scrap of Whisper White CS in Jet Black Staz on ink.
7. Color in the bunny image using your blender pen and the following ink colors: Creamy Caramel and Close to Cocoa for the fur, So Saffron for the shirt; Almost Amethyst and Lovely Lilac for the pants.
8. Cut the bunny out using your paper snips.
9. Die cut the label from a scrap of Whisper White CS using your Big Shot and the Bigz XL Matchbox die. Sponge around the edge of the label with Pretty in Pink Classic ink.
10. Stick the bunny to the left side of the label with a 2-way glue pen.
11. Stamp the greeting on the label to the right of the bunny with Jet Black Staz On ink. Use a Stamp-a-ma-jig if necessary.
12. Stick the label on an angle to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. "Thread" a large pink button with slivers of CS. Hold the ends of the CS in place with a mini glue dot. Stick the button to the card front with another mini glue dot. You're done!
