

Great Friend Card



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

*** denotes products from the Occasions Mini Catalogue**

- **Ink:** Versamark Pad
- **Paper:** Pale Plum CS, Rich Razzleberry CS, Cottage Wall DP
- **Accessories:** Stampin' Dimensionals, Snail adhesive, mini glue dots, Dotto adhesive, paper-piercing tool, mat pack, bone folder, Dazzling Diamonds glitter, heat and stick powder, Heat Tool, paper snips, Scallop Trim border punch, Big Shot, Beautiful Wings embossslits die*, Chit Chat rub-ons; **Non-SU supplies:** clear peel and stick rhinestones, pencil

Directions:

1. Take a 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Pale Plum CS and fold it in half with your bone folder to create a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card.
2. Center and stick a 4 ½" x 5 ⅝" piece of Rich Razzleberry CS to the card front with Snail adhesive.
3. Center and stick a 4" x 5 ¼" piece of Cottage Wall DP to the card front with Snail adhesive.
4. With a paper-piercing tool, template and a foam mat, pierce a line along the top and bottom edge of a 4" x 1 ¾" piece of Rich Razzleberry CS.
5. With a Scallop Trim border punch, scallop along one 4" side of a 1" x 4" piece of Pale Plum CS. Repeat with a second 1" x 4" piece of Pale Plum CS.
6. Stick one of the scalloped pieces to the bottom, and the other to the top of the 4" x 1 ¾" piece of Rich Razzleberry CS.
7. Stick the scalloped piece to the card so that it is about 1 ¼" down from the top of the card.
8. Take a Whisper White greeting from the Chit Chat rub-ons and apply it to the bottom left hand corner of the Rich Razzleberry CS.
9. With the Big Shot and the Beautiful Wings embossslits die, die cut some butterflies with a scrap piece of Pale Plum CS. You will need the largest butterfly and the butterfly with the polka-dot pattern on it.
10. Stick your butterflies onto a scrap piece of paper using Dotto adhesive.
11. Pat a Versamark pad all over the butterflies. Sprinkle the butterflies with Heat and Stick powder and then heat with a Heat Tool.
12. Sprinkle Dazzling Diamonds glitter over the butterflies and heat a second time.
13. Remove the butterflies from the scrap piece of paper. Center and stick the small butterfly to the large butterfly using a Stampin' Dimensional.
14. Stick the matted butterfly to your card, using a mini glue dot, near the top right corner of the Rich Razzleberry CS.
15. With a pencil make little marks, between the greeting and the butterfly, where you would like your rhinestones to be. Peel off a rhinestone and place it on a pencil mark. Repeat for the remaining pencil marks. You're done!
