

# Happy Birthday Layout



## Supplies:

**Stamp Set:** Calendar Alphabet and Numbers (111610)

**Ink:** Basic Black Classic ink

**Paper:** Whisper White CS, textured So Saffron CS (12" x 12"); Real Red CS, Crushed Curry CS, Brocade Blue CS and Happy B-day Simply Scrappin' kit

**Accessories:** Snail adhesive, 2-way glue pen, Big Shot, Sparkle Sizzlit, Stampin' Up! Timeless Type Junior Alphabet, ½" circle punch, Styled Silver Hodgepodge Hardware, Real Red ½" Sending Love Epoxy Brads, Real Red ⅝" Grosgrain ribbon, paper-piercing tool, mat pack, Stampin Dimensionals; **Non-SU supplies:** stapler, Cricket Expression, SCAL software, Script font from computer

## Dimensions:

**So Saffron 12" x 12" CS:** 2 sheets

**Real Red 12" x 12" CS:** 3 ½" x 12" piece to cut title with Cricket Expression machine, five 3 ¼" x 4 ¼" pieces

**Whisper White 12" x 12" CS:** two 4" x 12" pieces, five 3" x 4" pieces

**Crushed Curry 8 ½" x 11" CS:** scrap piece to die cut two Sparkle Sizzlit die pieces

**Brocade Blue 8 ½" x 11" CS:** 2" x 8 ½" piece to die cut the title and one Sparkle Sizzlit die piece

**Happy B-day Simply Scrappin' kit:** From the striped DP cut two 1 ½" x 12" strips, from the happy b-day DP cut four 1" x 12" pieces

**Real Red ⅝" Grosgrain ribbon:** 28", cut into two 14" pieces

### **Directions:**

1. Center and stick one of the 3" x 4" pieces of Whisper White CS to one of the 3 ¼" x 4 ¼" pieces of Real Red CS with Snail adhesive. Repeat with the remaining four pieces.
2. With a Big Shot and the Stampin' Up! Timeless Type Junior Alphabet, die cut the "Happy" letters for the title from the 2" x 8 ½" piece of Brocade Blue CS.
3. With the Big Shot and the Sparkle die, die cut two sparkles from a scrap piece of Crushed Curry CS and one sparkle from the remaining piece of Brocade Blue CS.
4. With a Cricket Expressions machine, die cut the "Birthday" letters for the title out of Real Red CS with any script font on your computer. If you do not have the Cricket Cutter you can use the Big Shot and one of the Stampin' Up! alphabet dies.
5. From a scrap piece of Real Red CS punch out two circles with a ½" circle punch.
6. Using Snail adhesive, stick the 1 ½" x 12" piece of striped DP about ½" up from the bottom edge of both So Saffron 12" x 12" pieces of CS.
7. With Snail adhesive, stick one of the 1" x 12" pieces of happy b-day DP to the page so that the bottom edge of the DP is touching the top edge of the striped DP. Repeat with the second page.
8. Lay one of the 14" pieces of Real Red ⅝" Grosgrain ribbon along the seam of the two DP pieces. Staple the ribbon to the CS with two staples on each ribbon end. Trim the ribbon ends with ribbon scissors. Repeat this step on the other page with the second 14" piece of ribbon.
9. Place some Snail adhesive along the back left and right edges ONLY of the 4" x 12" piece of Whisper White CS, and then stick it to the page so that the bottom edge of the CS is touching the top edge of the happy b-day DP. Repeat with the second piece on the other page.
10. Place some Snail adhesive along the back left and right edges ONLY of the 1" x 12" piece of happy d-bay DP, and then stick it to the top of the 4" x 12" piece of Whisper White CS. The top of the Whisper White CS will touch the bottom edge of the DP. Repeat with the remaining piece of happy b-day DP on the other page.
11. Tuck two of the matted Whisper White CS pieces underneath the DP/Whisper White CS on the right hand page, and tuck three of them underneath the DP/Whisper White CS piece on the left hand page. Once you have placed your pictures on them you can stick them in place with Snail adhesive.
12. Center the "Happy" letters on the right hand page in between the left edge of the CS and the edge of the matted CS pieces. Stick the letters to the page with a 2-way glue pen once you have them centered.
13. Take the die cut "Birthday" letters and stick them to the page with a 2-way glue pen directly over the top piece of happy b-day DP. Make sure you only place glue along the bottom of the letters so that you can still slide the matted Whisper White CS pieces behind the title.
14. Take one of the Crushed Curry Sparkles and stick it to the right hand page beside the "y" in "Birthday" with a 2-way glue pen.
15. With a paper-piercing tool and foam mat, pierce a hole through the center of the two Real Red punched ½" circles.
16. Insert a silver brad through the hole. Repeat with the second Real Red ½" circle.
17. With a Stampin' Dimensional stick one of the Real Red ½" circles to the center of the Crushed Curry Sparkle on the right hand page.
18. On a scrap piece of Whisper White CS stamp the year with Basic Black Classic ink.
19. Cut the stamped piece of CS to fit behind the hodgepodge hardware and stick to the bottom right side of the right hand page with Snail adhesive. Lay the Hodgepodge hardware piece over the stamped CS and with a paper-piercing tool and foam mat, pierce a hole through the sides of the hardware. Insert a silver brad into each side of the hardware. You are now finished the right hand page!
20. Stick the remaining Crushed Curry Sparkle on the top of the Whisper White CS, 3 ½" in from the left side of the page, with a 2-way glue pen. Stick the second ½" Real Red circle with the silver brad to the center of the sparkle with a Stampin' Dimensional.
21. Stick the Brocade Blue Sparkle to the page to the right of the Crushed Curry Sparkle and a little above it.
22. With a paper-piercing tool and foam mat, pierce a hole through the CS in the center of the Brocade Blue Sparkle. Insert a Real Red ½" Sending Love Epoxy brad. You're done!
