

My Wonderful Friend



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

- **Stamps:** In a Word, Wonderful Favorites, Just Perfect Alphabet, With All My Heart*
- **Ink:** Basic Black, Pumpkin Pie, Tempting Turquoise, Old Olive and Rose Red Classic inks
- **Paper:** Tempting Turquoise CS, Whisper White CS, Basic Black CS, Pumpkin Pie CS, Old Olive CS, Rose Red CS
- **Accessories:** Snail adhesive, mini glue dots, bone folder, Dazzling paper snips, Playground designer buttons, Sherbet designer buttons, Stamping Sponges; **Non-SU supplies:** painters masking tape

Directions:

1. Take an 8" x 7" piece of Tempting Turquoise CS and fold it in half with your bone folder to create a 4" x 7" card.
2. Center and stick a 3 5/8" x 6 5/8" piece of Basic Black CS to the card front with Snail adhesive.
3. Tear four pieces of Painters masking tape so that the ends are jagged. Lightly stick the four pieces of tape to the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece of Whisper White CS, spacing the tape evenly on the CS.
4. With a wedge of a Stamping Sponge, sponge around the top piece of tape in a circular motion with Pumpkin Pie Classic ink. The second piece of tape is sponged with Tempting Turquoise Classic ink, the third will be sponged with Old Olive Classic ink and finally the bottom piece of tape will be sponged with Rose Red Classic ink.
5. Gently peel the tape off of the CS.
6. With a Stamp-a-ma-jig and Basic Black Classic ink, stamp the greetings where the tape was removed.
7. With paper snips cut a very thin piece of Pumpkin Pie CS, Tempting Turquoise CS, Old Olive CS and Rose Red CS. Insert the CS into the coordinating buttons.
8. Stick both ends of the CS sliver to the back of each button using a mini glue dot. Trim the ends of the CS sliver.
9. Stick each button to the coordinating sponged greeting "window" on the Whisper White CS using a mini glue dot.
10. Center and stick the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece of Whisper White CS to the card with Snail adhesive. You're done!
