

Pocket Card with Insert



Supplies:

Stamps: Funky Four, Hodgepodge Happiness (Stampin' Up!)

Ink: Real Red and Old Olive Stampin' Write Markers (Stampin' Up!);

Memento Tuxedo Black ink (Tsukineko)

Paper: Early Espresso CS, Real Red CS, Whisper White CS, Play Date Designer Paper (Stampin' Up!);

Accessories: Scallop Trim Border Punch, Real Red Satin Ribbon, Top Note Die, Big Shot, Sticky Strip, mini glue dots, bone folder, Stamp-a-ma-jig (Stampin' Up!); scoring board (Martha Stewart); linen thread (Papertrey Ink); Bow Easy (other)

Dimensions:

- Early Espresso CS: a 5 ½" x 7 ¾" piece scored at 4 ¼" and 6 ¾"
- Real Red CS: 2 ¾" x 5 ¼" and a large scrap
- Whisper White CS: a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" piece (to die cut the Top Note)
- Play Date DP (olive pattern): a 3" x 5 ¼" piece
- Play Date DP (flower pattern): a 2 ¼" x 5 ½" piece
- Real Red Satin Ribbon: a 7" piece and a 14" piece

Directions:

1. Score the Early Espresso CS as directed in the dimensions section. Crease and fold inwards along the 4 ¼" score line. Crease and fold in the opposite direction at the 6 ¾" score line. You will end up with three "panels" – a 4 ¼" panel, a 2 ½" panel and a 1" panel.
2. Punch along the outer edge of the 1" panel with the scallop trim border punch.
3. Stick the 3" x 5 ¼" piece of olive patterned paper along the outer edge of the 4 ¼" wide panel leaving an even border on three sides – there will be about a 1 ½" gap between the bottom edge of the patterned paper and the 4 ¼" score line.
4. Place a strip of Sticky Strip along the left and right edge of the 2 ½" panel. Peel the red backing off and then fold that panel inwards and stick it to the 4 ¼" panel.
5. Stick the Real Red CS piece to the outside of the 2 ½" wide panel leaving an even border at the bottom, left and right edges. Center and stick the flower patterned paper to the Real Red CS, leaving an even border around the bottom, left and right edges.
6. Lay a 7" piece of satin ribbon across the small 1" flap. Bring the ends around to the underside of the flap and stick them down. Stick the 1" flap to the 2 ½" panel with Sticky Strip.
7. Gather the ribbon using a small piece of linen thread tied in a knot about 1 ½" in from the left edge of the card.
8. Tie the 14" piece of ribbon in a bow (I used a bow easy). Stick the bow over the linen thread knot with mini glue dots.
9. Die cut a Top Note Die out of Whisper White CS. Stick it onto a scrap of Real Red CS, and trim around it, leaving about a ⅛" border all around.
10. Stamp the flower in the top right corner using the Real Red and Old Olive Stampin' Write Markers. Stamp the greeting to the left of the flower with black ink. Attach a gift card or write a greeting and insert into pocket. You're done!
