

Retro "Hi" Card



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

** denotes products from the Occasions Mini Catalogue*

- **Ink:** Chocolate Chip Craft ink
- **Paper:** Kraft CS, Taken with Teal CS, Sweet Pea DP Stack*
- **Accessories:** Snail adhesive, bone folder, paper snips, paper-piercing tool, mat pack, heat tool, Ice Circle Rhinestone brads, On Board Timeless Type, Dotto adhesive

Directions:

1. Take a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of Kraft CS and fold it in half with your bone folder. This will create a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card.
2. Center and stick a 4" x 4" piece of DP from the Sweet Pea DP stack onto a 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Taken with Teal CS.
3. Temporarily stick your chipboard letters to a piece of scrap paper using Dotto adhesive.
4. Ink up the chipboard letters with Chocolate Chip Craft ink. Heat with a heat tool to dry.
5. Stick the chipboard letters to the bottom right corner of the DP using Dotto adhesive.
6. Pierce two holes, one on top of the other, in the top left corner of the DP.
7. Insert a large turquoise rhinestone brad into each hole. Open up the prongs on the back to secure in place.
8. Center and stick the matted DP to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals. You're done!
