

Scalloped Easter Card



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

*** denotes products from the Occasions Mini Catalogue**

- **Stamps:** a Good Egg, Teeny Tiny Wishes
- **Ink:** Jet Black Staz On ink, Basic Black Classic ink, So Saffron watercolor wonder crayon, So Saffron Classic ink, Pumpkin Pie Classic ink
- **Paper:** Whisper White CS, Chocolate Chip CS, So Saffron CS, Tea Party DP
- **Accessories:** Sticky Strip, Snail adhesive, paper-piercing tool, foam mat, Square Ice Rhinestone Brads, Chocolate Chip Satin ribbon, Big Shot, Scallop Circle Bigz XL die, Circle Scissors Plus, Glass Mat, paper snips, bone folder, Stamp-a-ma-jig, blender pen

Directions:

1. Take a 3 ¾" x 11" piece of So Saffron CS and fold it in half with your bone folder to create a 3 ¾" x 5 ½" card.
2. Center and stick a 3 ¾" x 5 ½" piece of Tea Party DP to a 3 ½" x 5 ¼" piece of Chocolate Chip CS.
3. Pierce two holes one on top of the other in the bottom left corner of the DP with your paper-piercing tool and foam mat.
4. Insert two small square lilac brads into the holes – twist the brads so that they are a diamond shape rather than a square shape.
5. Center and stick the matted DP piece to the So Saffron CS with Snail adhesive.
6. Die cut a scalloped circle out of Chocolate Chip CS with the Scallop Circle die and your Big Shot. Fold it in half with a bone folder.
7. Cut a 4" circle out of Tea Party DP with the Circle Scissors Plus and the Glass Mat. Fold it in half with a bone folder.
8. Take a 5 ½" piece of Chocolate Chip Satin ribbon and lay it across the circle, about 1/8" down from the folded edge. Bring the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the DP and stick them down with Snail adhesive.
9. Place some Sticky Strip on the back of the scalloped & folded Chocolate Chip CS circle. Peel the red backing off of the Sticky Strip on one side of the circle, center and fold it over the top of the card and stick it down. Remove the red backing from the Sticky Strip on the other half of the scalloped circle and stick it down.
10. Place some Snail adhesive on the back of the DP circle and stick it down to the folded Chocolate Chip scalloped circle.
11. Take a 14" piece of Chocolate Chip Satin Ribbon and tie it in a bow around the ribbon on the folded DP circle.
12. Stamp a chick from the A Good Egg stamp set onto a scrap of Whisper White CS with Jet Black Staz On ink. Color it in using a blender pen and a So Saffron watercolor wonder crayon, So Saffron Classic ink and Pumpkin Pie Classic ink.
13. Cut out the chick with paper snips leaving a small border around it.
14. Stick the chick to the bottom right of the card front.
15. Stamp your greeting to the left of the chick using Basic Black ink and a Stamp-a-ma-jig if necessary. You're done!
