

Sweet Girl



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Fresh Alphabet (Papertrey Ink)
- **Ink:** Early Espresso Craft ink (Stampin' Up!); Brown Pitt pen (Faber-Castell); RV09 marker (Copic)
- **Paper:** Bermuda Bay CS (retired) (Stampin' Up!); Hibiscus Burst CS (Papertrey Ink); Java CS (Bazzill); Sweet Tooth Collection DP (Bo Bunny)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, paper snips, paper cutter and scoring blade, Bermuda Bay Polka Dot Grosgrain ribbon (retired), Basic Rhinestones, Decorative Label punch (Stampin' Up!); Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon (Papertrey Ink); Chipboard Layered embellishments (Bo Bunny); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); Heat tool, Super Fine Detail Clear embossing powder (Ranger); Red Liner Tape (Sunny Stampin' Store)

Dimensions:

- Java CS: a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece
- Bermuda Bay CS: a 5" x 5" piece
- Hibiscus Burst CS: a 4 ⅞" x 4 ⅞" piece and a scrap piece
- Sweet Tooth DP: a 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece
- Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon: a 7" piece and a 4 ½" piece
- Bermuda Bay Polka Dot Grosgrain ribbon: a 7" piece and a 4 ½" piece

Directions:

1. Fold the 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of Java CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card base.
2. Center and stick the 5" x 5" piece of Bermuda Bay CS to the Java CS card base with double sided adhesive. Set aside for a moment.
3. Center and stick the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of DP to the 4 ⅞" x 4 ⅞" piece of Hibiscus Burst CS, using double sided adhesive. Set aside for a moment.
4. Lay the 7" piece of Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon on your grid paper. Place a few dots of double sided adhesive along the center of the ribbon. Center and stick the 7" piece of Bermuda Bay Polka Dot Grosgrain ribbon to the 7" piece of Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon.
5. Lay the matted ribbon along the bottom of the matted DP about 2" up from the bottom of the DP. Wrap the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the paper and stick them down with double sided adhesive. Make sure to stick down the ends from both pieces of ribbon to the back of the CS.
6. Center and stick the matted DP to the card base, leaving equal borders on all four sides, with double sided adhesive.
7. Place a small piece of red liner tape centered on the back of the 4 ½" piece of Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon. Peel the red backing and fold one end of the ribbon over, sticking it down to the red liner tape, creating a looped end. Repeat with the second end, creating a bow.
8. Repeat Step 7 with the 4 ½" piece of Bermuda Bay Polka Dot Grosgrain ribbon, creating a slightly smaller bow.
9. Center and stick the Bermuda Bay Polka Dot Grosgrain ribbon bow to the Hibiscus Burst Grosgrain ribbon bow with a small piece of red liner tape. Set aside for a moment.
10. Stick the Ice Cream layered chipboard embellishment to the left hand side of the card base on a slight angle. Set aside for a moment.
11. Punch out a label from the scrap piece of Hibiscus Burst CS, using the Decorative Label punch.

12. Cut the top ¼" off the top of the label with a paper cutter.
13. Draw a dashed line around the outer edges of the two pieces of the label, with the brown Pitt Pen.
14. Stamp the greeting onto the bottom (the larger side) of the label, using Early Espresso Craft ink.
15. Sprinkle clear embossing powder over the stamped image. Tap off the excess embossing powder.
16. Heat the embossing powder with a heat tool, until the embossing powder is melted.
17. Stick the bottom of the label to the card base, with the top of the label just under the matted ribbon, with double sided adhesive.
18. Stick the top of the label to the card base, with the bottom edge (cut edge) of the label just under the matted ribbon, with double sided adhesive. Make sure that the top of the label is aligned with the bottom of the label.
19. Stick the matted ribbon bow to the right hand side of the card, directly to the matted ribbon on the card base, centered over the greeting label, with red liner tape.
20. Place the small flower Layered Chipboard embellishment to the center of the matted ribbon bow.
21. Color a medium clear rhinestone with the RV09 Copic marker.
22. Stick the colored rhinestone to the center of the small flower.
23. Place the "SWEET" Layered Chipboard embellishment to the right hand side of the card base just above the matted ribbon. You're done!
