

Valentine's Glassine Treat Bag



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

- **Ink:** Real Red Craft ink (101190), Pretty in Pink Craft ink (100857)
- **Paper:** Sending Love Specialty DP (117153)*
- **Accessories:** Snail adhesive (104332), Crystal Effects (101055), Pop-Up Glue Dots (104183), mini glue dots (103683) Chunky Essentials Glitter (108797), Chat Room Rub-Ons (117199), Sending Love Real Red Epoxy Brads (117270), Real Red 1" Double Stitched Grosgrain Ribbon (115607), Glassine Bags (117228), Stampin' Up! Perfect Polka dots Textured Impressions Folder (117335), Big Shot (113439), Standard Premium Crease Pad (113476), Medium cello bag (102757), chipboard hearts (see instructions), 1/16" handheld circle punch (101227), small paintbrush or pencil

Directions:

1. Take a 4 ¾" x 6 ¾" Glassine bag and emboss it using your Big Shot & the Perfect Polka dots embossing folder. You'll need to run it through in 2 different sections as the bag is too large to fit inside. Please refer to the video (see the link at the bottom of the page) to see exactly how it was done. The "sandwich" used was the multipurpose platform open to the innermost panel, a cutting pad, the embossing folder with the glassine bag inside, and finally the standard premium crease pad.
2. If you are filling your bag with baked goods then you may want to place them inside a medium cello bag so that they do not stain the glassine bag. Place your cello bag inside the glassine bag, and fold the top over (I did not secure it closed although you could do so if you desire).
3. Wrap a 15 ½" piece of Real Red Double Stitched Grosgrain ribbon around the treat bag and then overlap and stick one end of the ribbon to the other end with Snail adhesive.
4. You will now need two chipboard hearts in a larger and smaller size. I used the hearts from a retired Stampin' Up! chipboard collection – you could use the On Board Essentials Chipboard collection, or use the Hearts & Brackets Original die (item #115955).
5. Ink up the larger heart in Real Red Craft ink and the smaller heart in Pretty in Pink craft ink. Let air dry, or to speed up the drying process you could use a heat tool.
6. If desired, add a rub-on greeting to the Pretty in Pink Heart and then stick the Pretty in Pink heart to the Real Red heart using Crystal Effects.
7. Punch a hole through the Real Red heart with a handheld 1/16" circle punch and insert a Real Red epoxy brad.
8. Place a small line of Crystal Effects all around the outer edge of the Real Red heart and then sprinkle on some white Chunky Essentials glitter. Let dry.
9. Cut some ¼" wide strips of Sending Love DP (in whatever pattern and length you desire – make sure they are least 6" long). Wrap them around the handle of a small paintbrush or a pencil to curl. Stick them to the back of the Real Red chipboard heart with mini glue dots.
10. Stick the Real Red Chipboard heart to the Real Red Double Stitched Grosgrain ribbon with a pop up glue dot. You're done!
