

Starry Night Accordion Card



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

- **Paper:** Bermuda Bay CS, Old Olive CS, Garden Green CS, Summer Sun CS, Soft Suede CS, Chocolate Chip CS, SU watercolour paper, Basic Grey CS
- **Stamps:** Under the Stars
- **Ink:** Always Artichoke, Handsome Hunter, Basic Black, Tangerine Tango, Chocolate Chip, Pacific Point Classic ink
- **Markers:** Chocolate Chip, Creamy Caramel, Really Rust, Sahara Sand, Tempting Turquoise, Handsome Hunter, Mellow Moss, Real Red, Basic Black
- **Accessories:** Sticky Strip, mini glue dots, Tombow multi purpose adhesive, Dazzling Diamonds glitter, Stampin' Sponges, 2-way glue pen, Aqua Painter, Craft knife, Small Star punch, Paper Snips, Stampin' Dimensionals, Cutting mat

Directions:

1. Take a piece of Soft Suede CS and score @ 1 ¼", 2 ½", 4 ¼" and 6". Fold like an accordion with alternating mountain then valley folds.
2. Cut two pieces of Old Olive CS. One will be 1 ¼" x 5", and the other will be 1 ¾" x 5". Sponge the edges of each with Always Artichoke Classic ink and then fringe them. Stick them down to the front of the first two 'mountains'.
3. Cut a piece of Soft Suede CS 5" x 5". Sponge the edges with Chocolate Chip Classic ink.
4. Cut a piece of Bermuda Bay CS 4 ¾" x 4 ¾". Sponge the edges with Night of Navy Classic ink. Mat the Bermuda Bay CS on to the 5" x 5" Soft Suede CS.
5. Free hand cut a couple of rocks from the Basic Grey CS. Add crevices with your Basic Black marker, and then sponge with some Basic Black Classic ink.
6. Free hand cut three leafy sections for the tree. Sponge the edges with Handsome Hunter and Basic Black CS.
7. Free hand cut the Tree Trunk from Chocolate Chip CS. Lightly scratch in trunk marks with your Craft Knife, and then sponge with Chocolate Chip and Basic Black Classic ink.
8. Stick the Tree trunk on to the back panel and then with Stampin' Dimensionals, attach the leafy sections over the tree.
9. Punch out four stars from your Summer Sun CS and sponge the edges with Tangerine Tango Classic ink. Stick to the backdrop. Apply 2-way glue over the top of the stars and sprinkle with Dazzling Diamonds.
10. On Watercolour paper stamp out the bear 3 times, the racoon two times, the bug spray 2 times, and the mosquito twice. All colouring will be done by laying down marker on colour at a time, and blending with your Aqua Painter. Colours will be applied from lightest to darkest. The bear uses Creamy Caramel, Really Rust and Chocolate Chip. The raccoon uses Sahara Sand and Basic Grey, The mosquito's use Tempting Turquoise, Handsome Hunter and Mellow Moss. The Mosquito can uses Basic Grey, Real Red and Chocolate Chip. You will colour the bear once completely, once with just the belly and head, and once just the head. The raccoon will be coloured once completely and once just the head. The mosquito's will be coloured both fully, the can will be coloured once along the outside metal parts, and once just the center oval. Colour, Cut and assemble as paper tole using Stampin' Dimensionals.

11. Stick down your characters using Stampin' Dimensionals, and stick down your rocks with stampin' Dimensionals and glue. You are done!
