

Wedding Favour



Supplies:

All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.

- **Paper:** Very Vanilla Textured CS, Very Vanilla CS, Certainly Celery CS
- **Ink:** Pale Plum, Old Olive, Creamy Caramel
- **Accessories:** Sticky Strip, mini glue dots, Crystal Effects, Tombow multi purpose adhesive, Dazzling Diamonds glitter, Stampin' Sponges, White Smooch spray, Gold Smooch Spray, Big Shot, Sizzix XL Bigz box #2, Trio Flower punch, Boho Flower punch, 2 step bird punch, Pretties Kit, Empressor Stylus, Mat Pack
- **Non-SU:** Ribbon from fabric store, Spritzer with water

Directions:

1. Cut your box from your Bigz die using your Very Vanilla CS. Sponge lightly with Creamy Caramel Classic ink. Assemble with a piece of Sticky Strip.
2. Punch out numerous flowers from your textured Very Vanilla CS with your Trio Flower punch. With your Empressor Stylus at the pad from the Mat Pack, create a cup in the center of each flower. Spray the flowers with Gold Smooch Spritz. Glue it along the top edge all around the box. There are 24 flowers on this box. You will glue with your Tombow Multi-purpose adhesive. Dot the center of each flower with Crystal Effects and then sprinkle with Dazzling Diamonds glitter.
3. Punch out 4 sets of flowers with your Boho Flower punch and your Textured Very Vanilla CS. Sponge the edges of the flowers with Pale Plum and then spray with White Smooch Spritz, and also with some water. Crunch up each of the flower into a ball, and then undo them. This will add texture and dimension to them. Glue them one over the other with your Crystal Effects. The layers are varied so that one has 5 layers, one has 3 and one has 2 layers.
4. Punch out two leaves with your 2-step Bird punch from your Certainly Celery CS. Sponge the edges with Old Olive and then trim them shorter. Glue the flowers and leaves to the top, and then glue a small half back pearl to the center of each flower.
5. Wrap the ribbon around the center of the box using Sticky Strip at intervals and secure the end so that it ends in the center back.
6. Form a bow with the ribbon and then use a glue dot to secure it to the front. You are done!
