

# Wicked Challenge Card



## Supplies:

**All Supplies are Stampin' Up! unless otherwise noted.**

- **Stamps:** Bloomin' Beautiful, A Little Birthday Cheer
- **Ink:** Basic Brown Classic ink, Ruby Red Classic ink, Old Olive Classic ink
- **Paper:** Chocolate Chip CS, Close to Cocoa CS, Ruby Red CS, Very Vanilla CS
- **Accessories:** Snail adhesive, mini glue dots, Stampin' Dimensionals, paper snips, Masterpiece Ribbon Originals, Pretties Kit, Big Shot, Stampin' Up! Finial Press Textured Impressions Folder, blender pen

## Directions:

1. Take a 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Chocolate Chip CS and fold it in half using your bone folder to create a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card.
2. Dry emboss a 4" x 5 ¼" piece of Close to Cocoa CS with your Big Shot and the Finial Press Textured Impressions folder.
3. Lay a 6" piece of ribbon across the bottom of the Close to Cocoa CS. Bring the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the CS and stick them down using Snail adhesive.
4. Center and stick the embossed Close to Cocoa CS piece onto a 4 ⅛" x 5 ⅜" piece of Ruby Red CS.
5. Center and stick the Ruby Red CS piece onto the card front.
6. Take a 10" piece of ribbon and tie it in a bow. Trim the ends of the ribbon and then stick it onto the ribbon on the card front with a mini glue dot.
7. Stick a large cream half back pearl onto the center of the bow with a mini glue dot.
8. Stamp the single flower from the Bloomin' Beautiful stamp set twice onto a 2 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Very Vanilla CS in Basic Brown Classic ink. Color the stem of the flower with a blender pen and Old Olive Classic ink. Stamp the greeting in the top right corner with Basic Brown Classic ink.
9. Stamp the flower alone four more times onto a scrap of Very Vanilla CS in Basic Brown Classic ink. Center and stick the Very Vanilla CS piece onto a 2 ¾" x 3 ¾" piece of Ruby Red CS.
10. Stick the matted image to the Close to Cocoa CS, tucking the bottom of the CS just beneath the ribbon.
11. Color in two of the flowers entirely, and then only the front two petals of the other two flowers using a blender pen and Ruby Red Classic ink.
12. Cut out the two completely colored flowers and the two front petals only of the other two flowers.
13. Stick one complete flower onto each of the stamped flowers on the Very Vanilla CS using a Stampin' Dimensional for each. Stick the two front petals onto each of the flowers using a Stampin' Dimensional for each. You're done!
