

## Customize Your Easter Treat Matchbook

1. Use the template drawing below to determine your scoring dimensions – as I walk you through the steps, write the dimensions in the appropriate areas.
2. The small flap will automatically be scored at 1"
3. Lay your treat face up, flat on the table in front of you. Measure the height of your treat packaging. This will be dimension A. You treat really cannot be any more than about 5" high.
4. Hold down one end of the treat package and then using a ruler, measure how high the top end of the packaging lifts off the table. This will become dimension B.
5. Dimension C = Dimension A –  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
6. Your **CS height** = 1" + A + B + C
7. For one treat: Measure how wide the treat packaging is. CS width = treat package width +  $\frac{1}{8}$ "
8. For multiple treats like the project I made: Lay the treats side by side with the approximate spacing you want between them, then add  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". So **CS Width** becomes: multiple treat width +  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
9. Now cut your CS in the following dimensions: CS width" x CS height"
10. First score line: 1", Second score line: A + 1", Third Score line: (A + 1") + (B + 1").

11. I realize this may seem quite mathematical, but it's actually easy in practice. Simply write in pencil the measurements beside each letter.
